- No exhibitor may show the following:-

- An exhibit bred by or leased from the Judge or his family in the ring in which the Judge is officiating.
- An exhibit purchased from the Judge or their family in the ring in which the Judge is officiating, until after a period of 12 months.
- An exhibit produced by the Judge or their immediate family until after a period of 12 months
- An exhibit under a Judge where the Judge or immediate family have been rewarded in cash or kind for instruction of handler, rider or driver in the past six months.
- Under a Judge or members of the Judge's family who has received, purchased, or has contracted to receive payment for the sale or purchase of any horse in the past six months from the exhibitor.
- Under a Judge where a current lease of a horse is in place between the judge and the exhibitor.
- An exhibit under a Judge who has or has had a financial interest or current leases in the past or preceding twelve months.
- An exhibit in a class under the Judge who has produced an animal for that exhibitor in the previous twelve months.
- A progeny group sired by, or out of a stallion or mare owned by the Judge.

- Stables will be allocated and are not to be swapped, and/or exchanged under any circumstances

- No Portable yards are to be erected on the Bendigo Showgrounds (please order stables)

- No entries on the day

- Insurance levy, all handlers and riders who are NOT APSPB members must complete and sign the 'Non-Member release and waiver or liability' form

- Ring one will not be held up for any reason (ring one is priority) No refunds will be given for classes missed due to clashing

- No refunds will be given after the closing date
Tuesday 12th November, 2019

- All stallions and colts to be handled by competent handlers

- All colts from yearlings onwards must wear suitable bridle with a bit

- Stallions/colts are not to be used for child handler classes

- Rudeness to office staff, Committee members, Stewards or Judges may result in automatic non-acceptance of entries at future Shetland shows

- Read program carefully - starting times may have changed from previous Shetland shows

- All Shetlands must be registered, or foal recorded in the Shetland section of the APSPB. They must be entered in the name of the current registered owner,

who must be a current financial member of the APSPB.

- A Photocopy of each pony's papers and a copy of the owner's current APSPB membership **MUST** accompany entries.

- Entries will NOT be accepted if registration papers and memberships are not correct

- Suitability of attire - all riders, drivers and handlers must be suitably attired (no sneakers)

- Sun smart attire to be worn in the ring when exhibiting your Ponies

- Australian Standard Approved helmets must be worn by ALL RIDERS

- When entering in classes that state an age group for the handlers or rider, a copy of their birth certificate must accompany entries or be available for viewing on the day of the show

- Newcomer Shetlands must not have competed in a saddle class prior to January 1st of the year of the show

- Exhibits in broodmare classes must be either visibility in foal or have a foal at foot or be able to provide a vet certificate to verify the mare will foal in the current season

- **Height Verification** - All exhibitors are notified that it is a **mandatory** requirement that **all exhibits** competing at this show are required to be height verified in a manner determined by the Committee of the Shetland Pony Enthusiasts of Victoria.

Verification will only be conducted by a person duly authorised by the Committee in a manner approved by the Committee.

Any exhibit, which fails to meet a specific height requirement, may be presented to for a second occasion. The decision (after 2 attempts) is final and no further discussions will be entered into.

Exhibits may be transferred to an appropriate height class if applicable.

Any previously issued height certificates, irrespective of when or where they were issued, **will not** be acceptable as certification of an exhibit's height.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor, to ensure that exhibits are entered for classes for which they meet specified height requirements.

All exhibitors are reminded of the expected standard of conduct and to ensure they act accordingly.

- This event is run under the rules and regulations of the Australian Stud Book under the auspice of the APSB Victorian branch.

- Protests – a written protest accompanied by \$100.00 may be lodged with the Show Secretary as per the APSB Vic Br. Stud Show Protest Protocol (see Stud Show Schedule)

- No dogs are to be on the arena at all, and must be on a lead at all times whilst on the Showgrounds

FANCY DRESS - Saturday afternoon

HARNESS

- All harness exhibits to be 3 years old or over

- All exhibitors must wear blinkers - NO open or bitless bridles

- Drivers under 12 years old must be accompanied by a competent adult at all times

- Australian Standard Approved helmets **must** be worn by all **drivers under 18 years old**

- Novice not to have won a first prize in a harness class prior to this show

-Harness Classes are for Shetlands in single harness only unless otherwise stated.

SADDLE

- Placings to 4th may be awarded

- All saddle exhibits to be 3 years old or over

- Champion Childs Ridden Shetland, as well as the winners of the Ridden Newcomer, Leading Rein & First Ridden classes are not eligible to compete for Supreme Champion Ridden Shetland

- Australian Standard Approved helmets must be worn by ALL RIDERS

CHILD HANDLERS – to be held at lunchtime Sunday
