### **ENTRIES**

#### **No entry fees required throughout schedule**

Telephone entries accepted on Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> April between 1pm & 7pm by contacting phone (03) 5439 7211 or Email: jsmorvell@gmail.com

Only the Show Managers and the Chief Steward have the right to refuse an entry or entrant to the show.

**Late entries:** There will be no late entries accepted in any section where no other entries exist.

Exhibitor Entry Tickets can be collected from the Show Managers on arrival.

### **STAGING**

- All exhibits must be staged by 12 noon on Friday the 24th April
- The hall will be open for staging between 1pm & 9pm on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> April and 8am & 12 noon on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> April
- Measuring: 55cm from bench to top of flower.
- The height for vases of three blooms from bench to top of flower – 58cm
- Supports allowed in all sections. Foliage allowed.
- All blooms must be named on Exhibitor Entry Ticket
- All blooms must be staged in correct classification as per Australian Chrysanthemum Council Classifications book as applies to Victoria.
- All blooms must be from plants that have been in the exhibitors possession for at least 3 months prior to the show.
- Show vases must be used.

### **JUDGING**

Judging will commence at 1pm on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> April to be completed by 5pm.

Judges for all sections will be qualified judges. The Chrysanthemums will be judged according to the Australian Chrysanthemum Council Classifications

**The judges decision is final.**

### **PRIZE MONEY**

Prize money will be awarded at the Dinner on the Saturday night. Non attendees may collect prize money from the Treasurer on the Sunday.

No flowers are to be removed before 3pm on the Sunday.

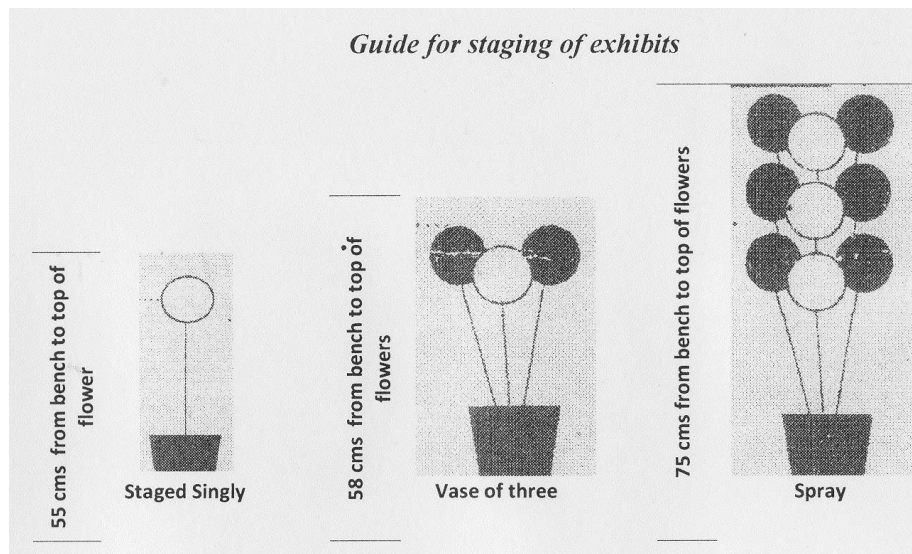

RULES & REGULATIONS (continued)**

- Container:** Is a vessel used to hold flowers. This includes bowls and vases. Arrangements can be viewed all around or from one side.
- Display:** To be judged on its display value, quality and freshness. All flowers must be named separately in all sections on cards supplied.
- Collection:** Is judged as a collection, variety, quality, freshness and staging.
- Vases:** (Between 3 and 10 blooms) Vases of three, to be staged 2 up and 1 down.
- Abbreviations:** **SS** Staged Singly  
**FVO** Front View Only  
**CVA** Colour Variation Allowed  
**ANS** Any Number of stems  
**DC** Distinct Cultivar (means 1 variety)  
**NND** Not Necessarily Distinct  
**DC/S** Distinct Cultivars (means each one different)
