- **All exhibits MUST be grown by the exhibitor**

- **Please do not move exhibits other than your own.**
- **All exhibits in a pot to be grown by exhibitor for at least 3 months prior to show.**

Definitions:

- **Spike – For horticultural show purposes is an inflorescence with more or less elongated axis. Usually bearing either stalked or stalkless flowers as in cymbidium, delphinium, foxglove or gladioli**
- **Truss – A cluster of flowers or fruit growing from one stem as in pelargonium, tomatoes or polyanthus**
