VEHICLE CATEGORY GUIDE

The following is intended as a guide for vehicle categories. You may enter your vehicle in whichever category you feel is most suited; however, you should be prepared to be judged on the appropriate criteria. The Early Falcon Car Club of Victoria Inc. reserves the right to re-categorise vehicles, as advised by a judge, if a car is seen to be in the wrong category.

CATEGORY DEFINITIONS:

Standard: Vehicles may be restored or partly restored. Accessories may be period, whether Ford original or aftermarket. Later accessories such as stereos, extractors, radial tyres etc. will be allowed, but the entry will lose points.

Modified: Any modification - mechanical, body or trim - will be classified as modified. This category will be split into two levels: 6 cylinder and V8.

ONLY PRE-REGISTERS WILL BE JUDGED.

All cars for judging need to be pre-registered by September 30.

PARKING REQUIREMENTS AND SAFETY REGULATIONS Pavilion Bendigo (October 12th and 13th 2024)

The following is a summary of regulations regarding the use of the pavilion in Bendigo for the Early Falcon Nationals 2024.

Dates: Saturday Oct 12th and Sunday October 13th

Bump-in time: Saturday October 12th 10:00 am – 3:00pm and Sunday 8:00am onwards

Bump-out time: Sunday October 13th 3:00pm

Note: We have the use of the pavilion for 2 days, giving opportunity to those displaying their vehicle to have them set-up in readiness for the show from Saturday morning.

Note: Please ensure that if you set-up on Saturday, you will be unable to move your car until Sunday afternoon. Take this into consideration when looking to attend events on Saturday (cruise to Maldon) or to being able to get around town.

There are NO EXCEPTIONS to this rule.

DISPLAYING YOUR VEHICLE

- As per pavilion rules, every vehicle must be displayed with a drip-tray below the engine sump.
- Please bring an appropriate drip-tray for the weekend. If you bring along cardboard, this will be thrown in waste as we cannot recycle cardboard with oil on it. (cardboard and drip trays are not supplied by the organisers or the club)
- Vehicles on display must have at least one half tank full of petrol and all battery terminals are to be disconnected.
- Vehicles on display must be moved only with the support and guidance of a parking
 official. There will be lots of people walking around over the two days, so safety is of the
 utmost importance.
- There will be ample room in the pavilion and every effort will be made to have ALL display vehicles indoors.



- Note: In the event that we have higher than expected numbers, you may have to park outside if you are late. In order to avoid disappointment, please ensure you arrive early to secure an indoor spot. (Bump-in begins 10:00 am Saturday and 9:00 am Sunday)
- THERE ARE NO GUARANTEED SPOTS OR RESERVING OF SPOTS FOR THE EVENT.
- The vehicles and display area will not be accessible after 3pm on Saturday afternoon. This also includes the dinner dance. If you wish to access the vehicle for whatever reason, this must be done only with the express authorisation of the event committee. The vehicles and display area will be secured by security staff present at the event.

ENTERING AND EXITING THE PAVILION

- There are 2 points of exit and entry.
- During bump-in or bump-out, you will be directed which of the two to use. Please ensure you follow the directions and instructions of the parking officials.
- Note: You must inform a parking official when you are leaving the event and they will escort you and your vehicle to the exit point.

IMPORTANT: No erratic driving, display of offensive behavior or language will be tolerated. This is a family oriented event folks, let's keep it safe and fun for everybody.
